You maintain control, however. If you wish a book, we will help you produce a manuscript. If you want more than one article, we will work with you to produce that number of final drafts.

## For Books

1. We will write a proposal for the new book you want produced. The proposal will contain a chapter outline, with a synopsis of each chapter. It will also contain a timeline for completion of the assignment and any questions your Edit911 editor needs you to answer to write the best possible manuscript for your book. This will be the beginning of a dialogue with you throughout this process so that the final product is something you will be proud to have published in your name.
2. After you accept the proposal, with whatever changes need to be incorporated, your editor will draft the first chapter for your review. We do this to ensure that our vision of your book matches your vision, that the tone and style remain yours, and that the emphasis in the book is the right one.
3. Your Edit911 editor will then draft the rest of the book. Your editor may request additional material from you during this process or clarifications to ensure the information is presented accurately. It's important to note that we will not ghostwrite massive amounts of material for your book. What we will do is remove signs that it's a dissertation, while adding small bits of text—where necessary—to make it read more like the work of an established scholar than a doctoral student. 5. Using your notes and requests, your Edit911 editor will revise the book into final draft form. ## For Articles

1. Your Edit911 editor will write a proposal for each article requested. The proposal will contain a detailed outline of the material for each article, specifying the emphasis and approximate word count. A timeline for completion of the project will also be included.
2. After you accept the proposal, with whatever changes need to be incorporated, your editor will draft the article for your review. Your editor will include any questions about material that needs clarification, any information that you need to supply to be added to the article, and comments about anything else that may affect the final draft. It's important to note that we will not ghostwrite massive amounts of material for your article. What we will do is remove signs that it's a dissertation, while adding small bits of text—where necessary—to make it read more like the work of an established scholar than a doctoral student. We may ask you to write a paragraph or two here or there—which we will then judiciously edit—if necessary to round out, fill in, more fully develop, or otherwise improve part of your work. ## Client Responsibilities

Although Edit911 will do most of the tedious revision work for you, your editor may need additional information from you or may suggest updating some of the information to ensure you have a book or article based on the most current information possible. Compared to the dissertation process, these requests should not be very time consuming and are intended to make your book or article even more publishable. We also need you to attend to the reviews and to answer the editor's questions in a timely manner.

1. Provide the editor with a complete copy of your dissertation.
2. Provide the editor with the publication guidelines of your chosen publisher. If you do not yet have one, we will follow the guidelines in the *Publication Manual for the American Psychological Association* (6th edition, 2010) or other suitable style guide. Send this information either as an email attachment or PDF file or as a link to the publisher's guidelines.
3. Reply promptly to queries from your editor for additional information or clarifications. The sooner you reply, the sooner your editor can complete the draft for your review.
4. Read the first draft(s) and note any questions or concerns you have so the editor may respond. This on-going dialogue will result in quicker resolution of any problems in the transformation process and ensure the final draft is exactly what you need.
5. Understand that when additional data from your research or clarifications about seeming inconsistencies in the data reported are requested, your editor is not commenting on the quality of your previous work, your committee, or your alma mater. The dissertation process is too unwieldy for everything to be caught in the time given for final rewrites and editing. Even the most scrupulous advisors and editors may overlook something that isn't important in a dissertation but may create a problem when that material is condensed into a book or article format.

Edit911 editors are concerned with ensuring that the data in your article are as accurate as possible, as thorough as possible, and as clearly stated as possible. Ultimately, responsibility for the data, the findings, and the implications and conclusions are yours. We ask only that you help us create the best possible work from your dissertation research.

6. If you have concerns with the direction of the work or the tone or style, communicate those to your editor as soon as possible. We want your book or article to be a true reflection of both you and your research. The sooner we resolve problems, the sooner you receive a finished product you will be proud to publish.

7. Please respect the limitations of Edit911 editors. We are not statisticians. We will not rerun your data to ensure accuracy of computations (although we may check basic computations such as percentages and addition and subtraction).

We may not be able to correct problems with figures and tables as they appeared in your dissertation because they were scanned into the paper or copied whole into the paper. We will identify what you need to change and resend to us. We will reformat or combine tables to conform to publication specifications.

We cannot look up your references to ensure accuracy of information (especially URL addresses) or locate doi numbers. We will, however, identify what information is missing so you can supply it to us for reformatting.

We cannot supply illustrations or content not already in your dissertation. You will need to supply anecdotes, illustrations, vignettes, and so forth to enrich your material and increase its relevance to your reader. We will suggest ideas to the best of our abilities, but we cannot write the material for you.
